

Required Documents for Qualification Endorsement for LTR Visa

Dependents

Personal Document

- If the original documents are **not in English or Thai**, you are required to submit a **certified or notarized translation in English or Thai only**.

<input type="checkbox"/> Passport	<p>Passport Requirements for LTR Visa Application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A copy of your current passport, which will be used for the LTR visa stamp with no less than 6 months of validity remaining and at least 2 blank pages for LTR Visa and stay permit stamps. Scanned PDF must include biodata page and all pages with Thai Immigration stamps. Arrange all pages in chronological order as a double-page spread in one PDF file. Applicants who have TM.47 form must upload a scanned PDF version as a separate file. Old passports may be requested for further verification if needed. <p>Note: Damaged passports will not be accepted by the Immigration Bureau for your visa on the appointment day.</p> <p><i>*Signs of damage: water damage, significant wear/tears, missing pages or unofficial markings. Immigration officers may refuse service if damage is observed.</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Photograph	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clear passport-size photo on white background (Max file size 2 MB) Formal/business attire (no T-shirts) No glasses, headgear or accessories Photo must be taken within 6 months
<p>The paper form T.M.6 card has now been replaced by the electronic Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC)</p>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC)	<p>Only for those who entered Thailand after May 1st, 2025.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> T.M.6 Card	<p>Only for those who entered Thailand before July 1st, 2022, or those who entered through a land border checkpoint and were issued T.M.6 card</p>

Document	Details
<input type="checkbox"/> Consent form for sponsorship of a dependent	<p>Sign the Consent Form for Sponsorship of a Dependent to confirm your relationship with the main LTR applicant, who will be fully responsible for the dependent's financial support, accommodation, health care, and all other necessary expenses during their stay in Thailand.</p> <p>Note: the LTR applicant can be downloaded from our website, Application form menu (file name: 'Consent Form for Sponsorship of Dependent')</p>
To be requested on a case-by-case basis.	
<input type="checkbox"/> A medical certificate	<p>A medical certificate issued by a hospital or medical center indicates that the applicant requires assistance with daily living activities from the support of a primary caregiver.</p> <p>The certificate must not be older than 6 months.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the original documents are not in English or Thai, you are required to submit a certified or notarized translation in English or Thai only. <p>Evidence of family relationship e.g. marriage certificate, birth certificate, etc.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/> Marriage certificate	<p>Legal documentation of their relationship that valid in the country where their passport was issued.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A copy of marriage certificate must be no older than 6 months <p>If your marriage certificate was issued more than 6 months before the application date, please proceed as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Contact the consulate or embassy of your country of nationality to notarize your marriage certificate. Have the notarized marriage certificate legalized by your country's Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Have the legalized marriage certificate further certified by the Legalization Division, Department of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.

Child	
<p>Please be informed that under the LTR visa policy, only children under 20 years of age are eligible to be dependents of an LTR visa holder. Therefore, once a dependent turns 20, the visa will automatically become invalid.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/> Adopted child	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Birth Certificate • Adoption Certificate • Court Order of Adoption
<input type="checkbox"/> Stepchild	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Birth Certificate • Court Order of Adoption (If the main LTR applicant is the stepfather or stepmother of the child) • Marriage certificate between the child's father or mother and the main LTR applicant

Evidence of Health Insurance

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This can optionally be submitted later, in which case the applicant must submit a signed **Document Request Acknowledgement Form** in place of the actual document.

If chosen to do so, insurance documents will later be requested by the relevant government authority once the application status has been updated to: **Consideration by Government Agencies**.

The applicant must provide **one** of the following documents:

<input type="checkbox"/> Health Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must cover the entire duration of stay in Thailand for hospitalization and medical treatment at least USD 50,000 with a remaining coverage period of at least 10 months. • Group health insurance policy must provide at least USD 50,000 per person. • Life insurance without health insurance and travel insurance are not accepted.
OR	
<input type="checkbox"/> Social security (SSO)	<p>Evidence showing valid Social Security (SSO) benefits covering hospitalization and medical treatment in Thailand, including the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The latest month's SSO payment receipt • The employee's name list submitted by the company for SSO • The SSO card
OR	
<input type="checkbox"/> Financial evidence or bank statement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must show a deposit of no less than 25,000 USD which has been held and maintained for no less than 12 months at the time of application.

Note: The officer may request additional documents to support the consideration of the application.
